Campaigning for a bigger and better railway



The direct walking route from the station is along Station Hill, over the roundabout into Ipswich Street to the end, which then becomes St John's Street. The venue is on the right.

The St. John's Street entrance is opposite the bus station and car park, the entrance from St. Andrew's Street is best for those walking from the railway station, which is about 10 minutes away. Light refreshments be available. There is a good range of cafés and restaurants nearby.
